# **SPECIAL CATEGORY DESCRIPTIONS**

## **Associate Membership**

Individuals/Families who can provide proof of membership in another synagogue are eligible for this category. Voting privileges, opportunities to serve on the Board of Directors or policy-setting committees, lifecycle events, Torah School privileges, and Early Childhood discounts are NOT included with this membership. One High Holiday ticket per member is included.

## **Test Drive Program**

The Test Drive Program is an opportunity for anyone who has never been a member of Ramat Shalom to enroll their child/children in our Torah School (only available through Grade 4) and "test" their interest in becoming members of our community. This option is available for one year only. The child/children become the members for the year, with all membership benefits, including a High Holiday Ticket, (child's parent(s) may purchase High Holiday tickets at the "member family" rate) and member rates on social and educational programming. Child's parent(s) is/are eligible to participate in member programming.

## Welcome Home Program

An incentive program to encourage past Ramat Shalom members to return to our congregation, this category offers a discounted membership rate for one year. Full membership rates apply year two and forward. "Welcome Home" includes full rights and privileges within Ramat Shalom and two High Holiday tickets (additional High Holiday tickets may be purchased at the member family rate). Maintenance fees resume in year two until paid in full. No dues reduction may be applied to the Welcome Home Program fee.

# **Student Affiliate Program**

This program gives children the opportunity to attend Torah School without any membership commitment from their family, in the same way that they would register for an extra-curricular activity. This program is only available for children in Kindergarten through Grade Two.
